

## **Sinai: 13 Eritreans were liberated, but only two reached safety in Israel**

Today we received a letter from an Eritrean man who lives in China. He is seeking information about his brother and a group of Eritrean refugees who were freed from people smugglers. Only two of them arrived in Israel, the fate of the other refugees is uncertain. EveryOne Group has alerted the Israeli, Egyptian and international authorities, asking that the refugees be guaranteed the rights laid down by international law.

"Dear Roberto Malini, Matteo Pegoraro, Dario Picciau (EveryOne Group), my name is Samuel K.G. from china. My brother Amanuel K.G. has been under the human traffickers since november. They asked us a ransom of 28,000 USD to set him free and i have managed to pay the money two weeks ago. I have been informed that he was released along with 12 people and they headed to Israel. Until then we had a telephone contact. This time 2 of the people who were with him, have already arrived in the Israeli refugee camp. They called and told me on the way to Israel they have been faced by the egyptian police and many of them including my brother have been caught and only the two of them have escaped. So if it is possible I want know wether he is save there, what are they going to do to him and if there is any way i can save him or call him. This time I am so curious and worried about him. This way I can not continue my study. Thank you for your help. Look for ward to hearing from. Best regards".
