The violations of human rights committed by the Eritrean regime over the last 25 years will be the main agenda of the session that will evaluate undoubtedly the report of the Commission of Inquiry, which on (06/27/2014) was invested by **the Human Rights Council (HRC) of the U.N**. of all the powers to investigate the Human Rights Violations in Eritrea on the ground.
