An Urgent Call to Action By All Who are Directly or Indirectly Involved in Human Trafficking

1. Rescuing our fellow Eritrean brothers and sisters who are victims of human trafficking is the responsibility of each and everyone of us. Therefore, we call on everyone to participate in this worthy effort at this opportune time that will be remembered in the chronicles of Eritrean history.

- 2. We ask that all Eritreans who are languishing in makeshift prisons under human traffickers, and are victims of gangrape, unfathomable physical/psychological abuse and trauma be handed over to safe UNHCR facilities where they can receive appropriate medical attention.
- 3. This chapter of Eritrean diaspora and hardship will soon be over, as is true with all seasons. As such, these are the days when we should strive to rescue our brothers and sisters from victimization of human trafficking. Not doing so now will only lead to regrets and self-condemnation once the season is over. These are the days of action, the time when we should make positive contribution to the cause of victims. This urgent call to action is especially true to those who have direct custody of Eritrean victims of human trafficking. We call on you to have compassion for the young lives who are in your custody.
- 4. This call to action also applies to those who have contact with human traffickers with the intent to help your loved ones. We call on you to forward this message to them, or to provide us with their phone numbers so we can engage them directly.
- 5. Once you decided to release those Eritreans, we will coordinate and try to facilitate to make sure they will be welcomed and accepted at UNHCR camps....
- 6. To those Eritreans who are engaging in human trafficking, please remember that the Eritreans who are being kidnapped, and are subjected to physical and psychological abuse, beating, rape and death are your fellow citizens, your young brothers and sisters. We ask that you engage in and contribute to stopping these abuses immediately.
- 7. This is an opportunity for you to amend the crimes committed against your own fellow citizens, and to reconcile with your own

people. We ask that you take advantage of this second chance and take the only path to reconciliation by handing over the victims under your custody to a place of safety, preferably to the custody of UNHCR.

In conclusion, for the fear of God who is the creator of all and for the sake of a clear conscience, we call on you to transfer all Eritreans who are under your direct or indirect custody to a place of safety. We ask that you take heed of the righteous call of your people, and that you respond to it by contributing to the worthy effort of ending all abuses, physical or emotional, against any and all Eritreans.
