

Honorable Tegadalay/Leader Tewelde Gebreselassie mothballed Sagem (Democratic Front for Eritrean Unity) in the 80s - 90s.

Mr. Aregay, perhaps you are aware our kids who are now residing in the Diaspora refer you and me as well other ex-EPLFites as “Sahel Outlaws” (ሸፋቱ ሳሕል).
