

'ERITREA OF TOMORROW SEMINAR'
AT 22ND ERITREA FESTIVAL IN FRANKFURT
(Seminar Eritra Nai Tsibah/Eritria al Qad)

The Eritrean Democratic Association and branches of the ELF-RC in Europe are pleased to once again inform all interested compatriots that on 4 August 2007, the 22nd Eritrea Festival in Frankfurt will conduct its usual public seminar under the general theme of 'Eritrea of Tomorrow' – Eritra nai tsibha/Eritria al qad.

Presentations by panelists would be interspersed by solidarity messages of distinguished guests who will include a representative of the Mayor of Frankfurt, and representatives of the Social Democratic Party (SPD), the Christian Democratic Union (CDU), the Free Democratic Party (FDP, liberals), other designated participants of the host country as well as speeches by fraternal Eritrean parties/organizations.

The study papers by panelists together with the keynote address of the Chairman of the ELF-RC and presentations of the Chairman of the provisional leadership of EDA-1 and designated representatives of Eritrean fraternal parties and organizations shall focus on the theme of how the present situation can be changed and how prepared we are to establish a new Eritrea where democracy, peace and justice prevail.

Among the panelists this year shall include:

Dr. Solomon Ghebregiorghis from London, UK, who will present a paper on: The Eritrean mindset and root causes of problems in Eritrean politics; and



Dr. Aklilu Ghirmai from Frankfurt, Germany, who will focus on federalism as one form of decentralization with the aim of opening debate on the relevance or irrelevance of this form of decentralization in the Eritrean setting.

Festival participants are, therefore, required to prepare themselves for active participation and constructive contribution in the public seminar which should lead the way to change and democratization in Eritrea.
