PRINCIPLES OF THE ERITREAN NATIONAL FRONT FOR JUSTICE

The Eritrean National Front for Justice, ENFJ, has its roots on the Eritrean Youth Movement for Democracy and Freedom, EYMDL, a merger of two Eritrean youth groups. The gradual expansion of EYMDL and to constitute various social layers of the Eritrean society has demanded revision of its structure. Consequently, the central committee of the EYMDL convened last October to assess the progress of the movement and passed a resolution to consider the developments. One of the deliberations is to change the name to the **Eritrean National Front for Justice (ENFJ)** as of October 22, 2022.

Our vision

- Ensuring that future governance structure is founded on the Eritrean people's values,
- Guaranteeing that human dignity and rights of citizens are respected,
- Building a country that is at peace with itself, its neighbours and the rest of the world,
- Advancing a democratic and prosperous country instituted on firm democratic foundations.

Who we are

- The ENFJ is a people's political force established to ensure the sovereignty of the Eritrean people and protect the interests of the Eritrean state.
- The ENFJ has critically evaluated the destructive nature of the military rule in our country and aims to bring an end to that rule and find a national solution based on clear political foundation, identity, vision, principles and objectives.
- The ENFJ is a people's force that is composed of the heroic children of the noble Eritrean people who have paid all kinds of sacrifices for the people and the country.
- The ENFJ sees itself as the link between the struggles of generations of the Eritrean
 people. It has a strong principle enshrined in the diversity and equality of the Eritrean
 people and thrives to ensure equal participation of all Eritreans in the affairs of their
 country.
- After flourishing clandestinely inside the country, the ENFJ has now reached a level
 where it has substantially expanded its presence and leadership inside and outside
 Eritrea. It is a front whose organization and structure are deeply embedded in the
 people.

Our main objectives

Our priorities

- Establishing a stable and peaceful political transition process that ensures the participation of all sections of Eritrean society.
- The ENFJ shall hand over power to a freely elected constitutional government. Once this task is accomplished, it will disband itself as a front.
